Any children in college or under the age of 18 that you claim as a dependent can use our new **EZ EXPRESS INCOME TAX ITEMIZER**, also available **online** at **www.haick.com/itemizers**. They can drop off the Itemizer with their tax documents and we will process the return at a discounted rate without having to make an appointment!

Most tax payers will continue to receive a form this year which reports your health insurance details to the Internal Revenue Service. A form 1095-A, 1095-B or 1095-C will be mailed to you from your insurance company. You must bring this form with you to your tax appointment or it could **delay the processing of your tax return**. If you do not receive one, please call your insurance company in advance of your scheduled appointment.

Lastly, **telephone scams** of callers posing to be the Internal Revenue Service have been rampant. Please be aware the IRS will never call you to threaten jail, lawsuit or otherwise pressure you into collecting outstanding taxes. If you receive this type of call it is a scam. **Do not ever pay the tax they claim you owe** and promptly report the scammers name and telephone number to the IRS at 1.800.366.4484 or at **www.tigta.gov**.
